REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

Admission into the Shield of Faith School of Ministry is dependent upon students completing the Student Standards of Conduct form and adhering to the regulations and commitments therein. High School students age 16 and above and adults 18 and older are encouraged to attend Shield of Faith School of Ministry.

TUITION & FEES

Tuition is moderately priced to encourage those desiring to increase their knowledge of Christian doctrine and ministry to participate in continuing education. The price includes textbooks and other teacher provided learning materials. All students are subject to a \$20 non-refundable registration fee due with the admission form.

Standard Fees (non-refundable)

\$40 for core courses

\$50 for all other coursework

FORMATS OF TEACHING/STUDY

Certificate Programs:

Courses are available in two formats:

- Distant learning & resident 9-week

Resident 9-week quarter courses:

Each class meets weekly for an hour and a half on Sunday afternoons.

Distant learning courses:

Course requirements include periodic lectures and in class discussion combined with assigned readings and written assignments.

COMPLETION

To graduate from Shield of Faith School of Ministry, students must complete and pass all core classes and all designated and elective classes associated with one or more certificate programs. Upon completion of all required courses, the Dean of Students should be contacted for a credit check to confirm and schedule the student for graduation.

Note: Completion of a Certificate from the Shield of Faith School of Ministry does not guarantee ordination or licensing for ministry from this organization. Students pursuing ordination or licensing should be knowledgeable about the requirements of their organization or association. In addition, students should research the admission and transfer policies of other institutions if taking coursework for eventual transfer.
